

PROHIBITION OF AND PUNISHMENT FOR RAGGING

Ragging in any form shall be strictly prohibited, within the premises of University or Faculty/ school/ college or Institution or outside the faculty/ school/ college.

Any individual or collective act or practice of ragging shall amount to a gross indiscipline and shall be dealt with under this Statute.

Ragging for the purposes of this Statute, ordinarily means any act, conduct or practice by which dominant powers or status of senior students is brought to bear on students freshly enrolled or students who are in, way considered junior or inferior by other students and includes individual or collective acts or practices which:—

- (a) Involve physical assault or threat to use of physical force;
- (b) violate the status, dignity and honor of women students;
- (c) violate the status, dignity and honor of students belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Tribes;
- (d) expose students to ridicule and contempt and affect their self esteem; and
- (e) entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gestures and obscene behavior.

The Deans/ Directors/ Principals of the Faculty/ school/ colleges, the Head of the Department of an Institution, the authorities of Faculty/ school/ college / University Hostel / Halls of Residence shall take immediate action on any information of the occurrence of ragging.

Notwithstanding anything in Clause above, the officer may also enquire into any incident of ragging and make a report to the Vice-Chancellor of the identity of those who are engaged in raging and the nature of the incident.

The Officer may also submit to the Vice-chancellor an initial report establishing the identity of the perpetrators of ragging and the nature of the ragging incident.

If the Deans/ Directors/ Principals of the Faculty/ school/ colleges or Head of the Department of Institution is satisfied that for some reason, to be recorded in writing, it is not reasonably practical to hold such an enquiry, he may so advise the Vice-Chancellor accordingly.

When the Vice-Chancellor is satisfied that it is not expedient to hold such enquiry, his decision shall be final.

On receipt of a report or a determination by the relevant authority disclosing the occurrence of ragging incidents, the Vice-Chancellor shall direct or order rustication of a student or students for a specific number of years.

The Vice-Chancellor may in other cases of ragging order or direct that any student or students be expelled or be not for a stated period admitted to a course of study in a Faculty/ school/ college/ Departmental Examination or that the result of the student(s) concerned in the examination or examinations in which they appeared be cancelled.

In case any student who has obtained degrees of the University are found guilty under this Statute, appropriate action for withdrawal of degrees conferred by the University shall be initiated.

For the purpose of this Statute, abetment of ragging whether by way of any act, practice or incitement of ragging shall also amount to ragging.

All institutions within the University system shall be obligated to carry out instructions/ directions issued under the Statute, and to give aid and assistance to the Vice- Chancellor to achieve the effective implementation of the Statute.

4. IEC college of Engineering & Technology has displayed the copy of the order on its notice boards.
5. He/She will maintain a minimum of 75% attendance throughout his/her stay in the college & we are aware that less than 75% attendance will mean his/her detention from appearing in the class test and semester university examination .
