



FELLOWSHIPS, SCHOLARSHIPS, STUDENTSHIPS, MEDALS, PRIZES

- The Academic Council shall initiate action in consultation with the appropriate Dean of Faculty and recommend the instituting of tuition free-ships, fellowships, scholarships, studentships, medals, prizes, etc. The Academic Council shall recommend these awards to the Chancellor for confirmation.
- It shall be the responsibility of the Dean of Faculty to ensure sufficient provision in the budget of his Faculty for such of the schemes approved by the Academic Council.
- The Board of Management shall have full powers to make rules and regulations for the purposes of award, suspension, or cancellation of the tuition free ship, fellowships, scholarships, studentships, medals, prizes and others approved by it:

Provided that the existing schemes of tuitions free-ships, fellowships, scholarships, studentships, medals, prizes, Merit-*cum*-Means Scholarships, Educational Loans and other concessions shall continue to be in force in respect of each of the constituent Institutes until such time as they are replaced, altered or otherwise dealt with by the Chancellor

- The tuition fee concessions may be granted on the basis of merit as may be decided by the Academic Council from time to time.
- The Students having 100% attendance in any semester shall be duly recognized by way of giving them certificate/ award.
- The students who maintain a CGPA of 10.0 out of 10 shall be duly recognized by way of giving them certificate/ award.
- The merit-cum-means scholarship/ award will be instituted for meritorious students maintaining CGPA more than 8.0, but who belong to below poverty line BPL category.
